Motorcycle Handlebar Switches TVS HLX is a switch device installed on the handlebar of a motorcycle for the rider to conveniently control various functions and systems. The handlebar switch is divided into left switch and right switch. Riders can operate these switches with their fingers or palms to control various functions of the vehicle.

Turn Signal Switch: Used to control the turn signal of the motorcycle. The rider can turn on or off the left and right turn signals by operating the turn signal switch.

Headlight Switch: Used to control the headlights of motorcycles. The rider can turn the headlights on or off by operating the headlight switch.

Horn Switch: Used to control the motorcycle's horn. Riders can sound the alarm by pressing the horn switch.

Brake Switch: Used to control the brake lights of motorcycles. When the rider presses the brake handle or brake pedal, the brake switch triggers the brake light to illuminate to alert vehicles behind.

Starter Switch: Used to start the motorcycle's engine. The rider can start the engine by pressing the start switch.

Clutch Switch: Some motorcycles are equipped with a clutch switch that requires the rider to hold the clutch when starting to avoid accidental starting.
